### 1- Matter and the Unseen

Answering the question: How does "matter" exalt Allah?

Matter with its minutest particles; such as electrons and smaller, is a form of identical, indestructible and immutable wave masses, unlike other waves, because they intricately follow vital and precise mathematical equations, and the least infringement thereof would destroy them. In this sense, determining the state of matter and its composition (crystalline or otherwise), its characteristics, its behavior and its reaction with whatever surrounds it, calls for "perceiving" matter with all its components down to the smallest of them; the nature of what surrounds it, and how it must react within different circumstances and according to specific inherent "regulations". renewal; all of these processes necessitate some informational codes or <programs> related to the set of genes specific to each organism. The existence of these codes or programs can not be explained through the standard chemical composition and the similar geometric structure of the genes of every individual species of organism. It requires a hidden and unseen force that has absolute power over its origin, behavior and life cycle.

### 3- Our surrounding and the Unseen

Answering the question: Why don't we see the jinn and the angels?

We see things with the help of light, and then we perceive them with the help of our human senses. In case of the vision, it is limited since we only see things that reflect light at wave lengths between 4 and  $7 \times 10^{-7}$  meters. As for hearing, we can only hear sounds with frequencies between 2500 and 4000 cycles per second. Outside these limits, we are unable to see things or hear sounds even if they were close to us or even if they lived and moved among us.

As for electronic detection devices, they interact with the molecules of the earthly matter (included in the periodic table of elements) and with the electromagnetic waves system (with sinusoidal equations) which are only one type of mathematically possible wave functions. However, no scientist can deny the possibility of the existence of beings made of different wave systems and heat waves that are imperceptible to our senses and our scientific means.



#### 4- Space and the Unseen

Answering the question: Where are the seven heavens as related to the one we see?

The sky, the galaxies with their billions of stars and the celestial bodies we see with our eyes, or through observatory devices, are different from each other in relation to the distance that separates them from the Earth; which can be estimated by thousands or millions of light-years. This means that each of them used to be in this relative position "since" a few thousand or a million years ago, and not at this present time. Hence, what we see in the sky, in space charts or in the celestial dome, does not represent the real image and is actually very far from the actual/current state. What we see is only an image composed of innumerable scenes taken at very disparate times. No one, but Allah, can know what has become of the real space in this universe; its components, its existence and its location at this very minute... nor the essence of the seven layers of the heavens!
