- Human minds cannot fully comprehend His essence.





God created time and space; He transcends both.

6 ALL PROPHETS TAUGHT THE SAME MESSAGE: WORSHIP GOD ALONE

ADAM	NOAH	ABRAHAM	MOSES	JESUS	MUHAMMAD ﷺ
 The first prophet who was taught to worship God alone.	 Called people to monotheism and warned against idol worship.	 The model of pure monotheism. He rejected idols and questioned inherited beliefs.	 Called his people away from idolatry to the worship of one God.	 Worshipped God, prayed to God and never claimed divinity. He taught monotheism.	 The final prophet who restored pure monotheism and preserved the original message in its final form.

None of the prophets claimed divinity. Followers altered their teachings after they passed away.

7 COMPARISON WITH OTHER RELIGIONS

	Christianity	Scripture affirms one God, but doctrines like the Trinity and deification of Jesus are later additions.
	Judaism	Historically monotheistic, but some limited God's message to a specific ethnic group.
	Hinduism	Early scriptures (Vedas, Upanishads) speak of one supreme Creator, later developed many deities.
	Sikhism	Affirms one Creator (Ik Onkar).
	Buddhism	Some traditions contain references to a supreme divine reality.
	Zoroastrianism & Others	Elements of belief in one supreme God are present.

All religions contain traces of the original belief in one God.

8 PROHIBITION OF IDOLATRY AND IMAGES



- Idolatry is rejected in Islam, Christianity, Judaism, Hindu scriptures and many other traditions.
- The book warns against:
 - Worshipping idols
 - Making images of God
 - Praying to saints or prophets
 - Seeking help through intermediaries

Worship should be directed only to God.

9 WORSHIP GOD ALONE




- Every person can pray directly to God.
- No priesthood or mediator is required.
- Salvation depends on sincere monotheism and righteous actions.
- Islam restores direct worship of the Creator alone.

No partners. No intermediaries. Only God.


10 PROPHETS WERE SENT TO ALL NATIONS



- God sent messengers to every nation and civilization.
- Similar moral teachings appear worldwide.
- Humanity originally shared one faith.
- Religious fragmentation happened gradually over time.

One message, many messengers, all for humanity.

11 CORRUPTION OF RELIGION



Religions were changed due to:

- Human desires
- Politics
- Cultural traditions
- Clerical authority
- Philosophical reinterpretations

- Idol worship
- Deification of prophets
- Religious hierarchy
- Polytheistic practices

People honored the righteous until they elevated them to objects of worship.

12 WHY ATHEISM INCREASED



- Complicated and contradictory doctrines
- Religious hypocrisy and corruption
- Abuse of authority
- Human suffering
- Excessive materialism

Many atheists reject distorted concepts of God, not the true Creator.



13 THE QUR'AN AS THE FINAL PRESERVED REVELATION



- Preserved from alteration
- Universally applicable
- Linguistically miraculous
- Consistent in monotheism
- Clarifies and corrects distortions

The Qur'an restores the original message and maintains pure monotheism.

14 HUMAN EQUALITY AND ACCOUNTABILITY

- No racial or ethnic superiority.
- Everyone is equal before God.
- Judgment is based on:
 - Faith
 - Intentions
 - Actions
 - Righteousness

Each person is accountable for their own deeds.

15 FINAL MESSAGE
