Do you believe that God has attributes of perfection?

If your answer is yes ... then His Holy Book Revealed for mankind must also be perfect.

Are you a believer of the infallibility of God's prophets (peace be upon them) and their purity from all sins?

Have you made a comparison between the attributes of God in the Old Testament and the Noble Qur'an?

I have attempted to provide consolidated information from resourceful books and web sites and arrange them in summarized comparative tables.

I appeal to the reader to examine this book with an unbiased mind and open heart to the truth because this is the only way that may lead to the right decision that shapes one's life in this world and the world to come.

Mentioning these texts are only for inference.

The Attributes of God (Allah¹) Almighty in the Noble Qur'an

The more I contemplate in this universe including its oddity, proficiency, consistency and creativity; I become certain that this universe has a creator.

The Creators Greatness is hard for man to comprehend. This Creator must be the Knower of the broadest boundaries of science.

Overall, the Maker of this universe is characterized by all the qualities, pride and perfection ... far above all the characteristics of defectiveness ... The Noble Qur'an has elaborated, drew attention and urged people to contemplate on God's blessings and favors.

The names and attributes of Allah are too many. Allah Almighty has gathered in the Qur'an the pros of the previous books, increased its perfection that is not in other books, making it the seal of all books, the most comprehensive and the most accurate book.

Allah promised to protect His Book, His Noble Self as mentioned in the text delivered by Divine Revelation the seal of the prophets and messengers, Prophet Muhammad (may Allah bless him and grant him peace), its abbreviation is: (PBUH)².

“Indeed, it is We who sent down the Qur'an and indeed, We will be its guardian” [Al-Hijr: 9].

The Muslim scholars proved the names and attributes of Allah Almighty as stated in Divine Revelation, along with faith and belief of their meanings and denotations: without hindrance, representation, distortion, adaptation, and diversion. They mentioned them with faith and belief of their meanings and denotations, they believed in Allah's attributes of perfection, and considered Allah free from imperfections and defects, with no analogy, and without hindrance, as Allah said **“There is nothing like unto Him, and He is the Hearing, the Seeing.” [Ash-Shura: 11].**

The study of the names and attributes of Allah are very important because the knowledge about Allah is the origin of faith and belief, and because they are the most powerful remedy, healing and protection from polytheism.

If people know the qualities of Allah, and know His Greatness, His Powerfulness, His uniqueness, His Limitless Mercy, His Mighty Strength, His Perfect Knowledge, the Sharpness of His Gaze, His kindness, no one can compare to Him. His Pride and Majesty, The Severity of His Revenge, His Immense Wisdom, and the inclusion of His Righteousness, they shall depart worshipping of false gods.

The believer thinks well of Allah Almighty and knows His Lord from His Beautiful Names and Attributes. Allah, Most Exalted, says: **“And to Allah belong the best names, so invoke Him by them.”** [AL-A'RAF: 180].

If the believer reads the attributes of Allah in the Noble Qur'an, he will be faithful and his belief will be shaped in a righteous manner that increases his faith. While the hypocrite denounces these names and attributes of Allah and becomes arrogant, so his polytheism increases.

Whoever knows His Lord's attributes shall love Him for His Greatness and Mercy. If he loves Him, he shall obey Him, such love will prohibit him from fault and sin, assist him to be patient in affliction, support him to do good deeds, and urge him for sacrifices.

When the believer thinks well of Allah Almighty, he shall improve his works, in hopes of pleasing Allah Almighty, because he knows that Allah is: the Most Gracious and Most Merciful, so he requests Allah's mercy and Heaven. If the believer commits sins, he shall not despair of Allah's mercy; because he knows that God is the Most Forgiving and the Most Relenting, so he thinks well of Allah and prays for repentance and forgiveness.

Allah considered that mistrust in His names and attributes from the reasons of being lost: **“And that was your assumption which you assumed about your Lord. It has brought you to ruin, and you have become among the losers.”** [FUSSILAT:23].

The Jews and Christians depart from pure monotheism by fabricating words about God that He has taken a son, “The Jews say, "Ezra is the son of Allah:" and the Christians say, "The Messiah is the son of Allah." That is their statement from their mouths; they imitate the saying of those who disbelieved [before them]. May Allah destroy them; how are they deluded?” [AT-TAWBAH:30].

Glory be to Allah above all, the one who needs a son is the weak one, who wants a son to live after his death, but Allah doesn't die and He doesn't need a son.

Those who need a son to assist them when they become old aged, as the creature is weak by nature, needs money and children, and needs supporters to help him during disasters.

However, Allah Almighty is the Self-Sufficient and the All Praise- Worthy: “O People of the Scripture, do not commit excess in your religion or say about Allah except the truth. The Messiah, Jesus, the son of Mary, was but a messenger of Allah and His word which He directed to Mary and a soul [created at a command] from Him. So believe in Allah and His messengers. And do not say, "Three"; desist - it is better for you. Indeed, Allah is but one God. Exalted is He above having a son. To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth. And sufficient is Allah as Disposer of affairs.” [AN-NISA: 171].

They have said, " Allah has taken a son." Exalted is He; He is the [one] Free of need. To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is in the earth. You have no authority for this [claim]. Do you say about Allah that which you do not know?” [YUNUS : 68].

And say, "Praise to Allah , who has not taken a son and has had no partner in [His] dominion and has no [need of a] protector out of weakness; and glorify Him with [great] glorification.” [AL-ISRA: 111].

What is the opinion of Islam about the Old Testament?

Islam did not acknowledge the scriptures comprised in the Old Testament, but Islam explicitly acknowledged the Torah revealed to Moses (PBUH), which Allah Almighty delivered and revealed to His Prophet as He said, “He has sent down upon you, [O Muhammad], the Book in truth, confirming what was before it. And He revealed the Torah and the Gospel.” [ALI 'IMRAN: 3].

This pure Torah was characterized by the most beautiful and splendid descriptions as His Almighty said, “Indeed, We sent down the Torah, in which was guidance and light. The prophets who submitted [to Allah] judged by it for the Jews, as did the rabbis and scholars by that with which they were entrusted of the Scripture of Allah, and they were witnesses thereto” [AL-MA'IDAH: 44] and said, “And We had already given Moses and Aaron the criterion and a light and a reminder for the righteous” [AL-ANBYA: 48].

After Islam acknowledged the real Torah which was revealed to Moses, the Noble Qur'an proved that the Jews had another Torah but it was not the right one previously revealed to Moses. The Jews took the name Torah, changed its content, distorted the words and nullified Allah's covenants, so Allah accused them for that distortion and challenged them to get the true Torah and convey it all over the world, as He said, **"So bring the Torah and recite it, if you should be truthful."** [ALI 'IMRAN: 93].

Allah also has revealed evidences about the distortion occurred in Torah as Allah Mighty said: **)... Say, "Who revealed the Scripture that Moses brought as light and guidance to the people? You [Jews] make it into pages, disclosing [some of] it and concealing much..."** [AL-AN'AM : 91].

Further, Allah said, **"O People of the Scripture, there has come to you Our Messenger making clear to you much of what you used to conceal of the Scripture and overlooking much. There has come to you from Allah a light and a clear Book"** [AL-MA'IDAH: 15].

Allah Almighty made the Noble Qur'an as a judge over other previous books: observer, guide and reformer for these books. **"And We have revealed to you, [O Muhammad], the Book in truth, confirming that which preceded it of the Scripture and as a criterion over it. So judge between them by what Allah has revealed and do not follow their inclinations away from what has come to you of the truth. To each of you We prescribed a law and a method. Had Allah willed, He would have made you one nation [united in religion], but [He intended] to test you in what He has given you; so race to [all that is] good. To Allah is your return all together, and He will [then] inform you concerning that over which you used to differ"** [AL-MA'IDAH : 48].

God's attributes in the Old Testament texts

1. Monotheism:

The Jews sometimes were monotheists as indicated by: 4. “Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: 5. “ And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might”. [Deuteronomy 6: 5-4].

5. “ I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God besides me: I girded you, though you have not known me: 6. “That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that there is none besides me. I am the LORD, and there is none else.” [Isaiah 45: 5-6].

But did the Jews associate partners in terms of Divinity?

The Jews associated other partners in Godhood, as they believed that the moon has an adverse impact on people; it irritates some neurological diseases such as madness and epilepsy "Arabic Bible Dictionary (page 743).

The Jews claimed that the planets predict the future and foresee the unseen. Moreover, they thought that planets have power in managing the universe and human life when they found the strange phenomena of the planets so they worshiped the planets instead of worshiping their Creator "Arabic Bible Dictionary (pages 958-959). “The beginning of the Jews, Zaki Shenouda (page 487).

1. “At that time, says the LORD, they shall bring out the bones of the kings of Judah, and the bones of his princes, and the bones of the priests, and the bones of the prophets, and the bones of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, out of their graves: 2 And they shall spread them before the sun, and the moon, and all the host of heaven, whom they have loved, and whom they have served, and after whom they have walked, and whom they have sought, and whom they have worshiped...” [Jeremiah 8:1-2].

5. “And he put down the idolatrous priests, whom the kings of Judah had ordained to burn incense in the high places in the cities of Judah, and in the places round about Jerusalem; them also that burned incense unto Baal, to the sun, and to the moon, and to the planets, and to all the hosts of heaven.” [Kings2 23: 5].

The Jews also associated partners in Divinity as stated in their books: 11. “ And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and served "Baalim": 12. “ And they forsook the LORD God of their fathers, who brought them out of the land of Egypt, and followed other gods, the gods of the people that were round about them, and bowed themselves unto them, and provoked the LORD to anger. 13. “And they forsook the LORD, and served Baal and Ashtaroth.” [Judges 2 : 11-13].

5. “And the children of Israel dwelt among the Canaanites, Hittites, and Amorites, and Perizzites, and Hivites, and Jebusites: 6. “And they took their daughters to be their wives, and gave their daughters to their sons, and **served their gods**. 7. “And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and forgot the LORD their God, and **served Baalim and the idol poles**. 8 Therefore the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hand of Chushanrishathaim king of Mesopotamia: and the children of Israel **served Chushanrishathaim** eight years.” [Judges 3: 5-8].

“All, except David and Ezekias and Josias, were defective: for they forsook the law of the most High, even the kings of Juda failed.” [The Book of Sirach or Ecclesiasticus 49 : 4].

Ahab (seventh king of Israel) worshiped the god "Baal" (Ba'l), then the children of Israel followed Ahab and spread the idol worship of "Baal" in Israel , that was in the time of the prophet Elijah (Elias) who forbade them from doing that: “**Do you call upon Ba'l and leave the best of creators**) (At-Tabari Interpretation of the Noble Qur'an As-Saffat: 125.”

The children of Israel repeated apostasy and polytheism many times during the reign of the judges, then they repeated that in the era of the kings, it was stated in [Kings12: 28- 30] : 28. “**Whereupon the king took counsel, and made two calves of gold**, and said unto them, It is too much for you to go up to Jerusalem: behold your gods, O Israel, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt.” 29. “And he set the one in Beth-el, and the other put he in Dan. 30 And this thing became a sin: for the people went to worship before the one, even unto Dan.”

What was mentioned makes any person doubts the validity of the current Old Testament and its purity from distortion.

The children of Israel worshiped these idols:

Is the doctrine of the children of Israel sound right?

God sent many messengers and prophets to the children of Israel to return them back to the correct doctrine: the pure monotheism, testify that the true God (Allah) is only one, He has no partner, and that Jesus Christ is only a messenger of God (Allah): “**And this is life eternal, that they might know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.**” [John 17: 3].

However, Jesus Christ's followers gradually changed the doctrine of monotheism to the doctrine of Trinitarianism (Father, Son, Holy Spirit), the three persons are distinct, yet are one "substance, essence or nature".

Is the doctrine of the oneness Lord similar to the doctrine of Trinity?

Are there significant differences between these two doctrines?

2. Non-change and modification:

One of the attributes of God in the Old Testament “**For I am the LORD, I change not....**” [Malachi 3: 6]. Also one of the attributes of God in the New Testament “**with whom is no variableness.**” [James 1: 17].

If God does not change from the Old Testament to the New Testament, so how then God, Lord, the Creator of the Children of Israel changed from the one Lord "Elohim" to the one Lord "Doctrine of the Trinity?" Does God change: die then become alive after death?

3. Compassion, mercy, forgiveness and salvation;

“**For the Lord is full of compassion and mercy, longsuffering, and very pitiful, and forgiveth sins, and saveth in time of affliction.**” [The Book of Sirach 2: 11].

“**and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, 7. “Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin.”** [Exodus 34: 6-7].

21. “**But if the wicked will turn from all his sins that he has committed, and keep all my statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die.**” 22. “**All his transgressions that he has committed, they shall not be remembered against him: in his righteousness that he has done he shall live.**” [Ezekiel 18: 21-22].

If a person falls into a sin and violates the commandments of God, then they must only repent with sincerity and seek God's forgiveness.

God forgives the sins of Man because He is the Merciful and Compassionate. He forgives and saves people.

Why didn't God forgive Adam after he had repented from his sin? rather than the alleged story that He sent (Jesus) after thousands of years from Adam's sin for: incarnation, redemption, crucifixion, and salvation to save people from the first Sin?

God is Merciful, Compassionate and Forgiver, so what happened is that Adam repented to God where he and his wife sincerely asked forgiveness ... so God forgave them?

4. Powerfulness and Capability:

Job confirmed that God can do everything, nothing is difficult for Him. **“know that you can do everything, and that no thought can be withheld from you.”** [Job 42: 2].

Is God able to reveal to prophet Adam words of forgiveness until he repents from his sin? Is it difficult for God to do this?

5. Justice:

Sin is not inherited, the one who made the mistake is the one to be punished; it is not just to punish another person rather than the one mistaken.

20. **“The soul that sins, it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son.”** [Ezekiel 18: 20].

16. **“The fathers shall not be put to death for the children, neither shall the children be put to death for the fathers: every man shall be put to death for his own sin.”** [Deuteronomy 24: 16].

29. **“The fathers have eaten a sour grape, and the children's teeth are set on edge. 30. **“But everyone shall die for his own iniquity: every man that eats the sour grape, his teeth shall be set on edge.”**** [Jeremiah 31: 29-30].

7. **“shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul?”** [Micah 6: 7].

If God is justice and does not kill children for the faults and sins of their fathers, if the child does not bear the iniquity of his father, and if **“every man shall be put to death for his own sin”**, was it fair to punish Jesus Christ for Adam's sin, for a sin which he (Jesus) did not commit, for the redemption of humans from sins that are not inherited?!

6. Non Resemblance :

“To whom then will you liken God? or what likeness will you compare unto him?” [Isaiah 40: 18].

“To whom then will you liken me, or shall I be equal? says the Holy One.” [Isaiah 40:25].

“To whom will you liken me, and make me equal, and compare me, that we may be alike?” [Isaiah 46: 5].

If God has denied his likeness to others, why, in the Old Testament, He was likened to a lioness and a bear? Why shameless, obscene and oppressive characteristics were attributed to God?

Is a god characterized by such attributes, qualified to be worshiped?

7. Eternal Alive and Sovereign:

“But the LORD is the true God, he is the living God, and an everlasting king.” [Jeremiah 10: 10].

If God is “eternal alive and sovereign”, how did God die on a cross? Who managed the universe when God died?

8. God is Unseen:

15. “Verily you are a God that hides yourself, O God of Israel, the Savior.” [Isaiah 45: 15].

20. And he said, You can not see my face: for there shall no man see me, and live.” [Exodus 33 : 20].

How did God appear incarnated in a human form to the prophets and messengers?

How did God incarnate in the womb of a virgin to come out to life from one of His creatures (Mary) as a God so that we can see God suckling, micturating and defecating?!

Was God - the Creator- born from his creature (Mary) to be seen in earth after that?

9. Non Regret:

“God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent.”) [Numbers 23: 19].

“The LORD has sworn, and will not relent...” [Psalm 110: 4].

One of the attributes of God is that He doesn't change His mind. Changing the mind is not from the attributes of God; it is impossible for God to bear human qualities, so He may regret His actions, or may feel anguished for decrees that He has previously ordained. So why did God regret His actions, as we will see in the pages of this book?!

10. God never gets tired:

....”the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, faints not, neither is weary? there is no searching of his understanding.” [Isaiah 40: 28].

It is impossible for God to bear human attributes, so He may be exhausted and need comfort on the seventh day!

Are there distortions in the texts of both the Old and New Testaments? What is the evidence?

The Jews and Christians acknowledged that the original scriptures were lost, and there were no original copies, the existing copies now were only translations. The oldest manuscript was from the fourth Gregorian century.

Authors of the (Arabic Bible Dictionary) say: Now we do not have the original manuscripts (for the old and new Testaments) which were written by the writers of the sacred Testaments.

The Jews and Christians said that the loss of such copies were due to the frequent incidents of persecution and the calamities through their long history. Among those incidents is the invasion of Assyrians in (722 BC), then the famous Babylonian invasion in (586 BC) which resulted in the destruction of the Temple and the Children of Israel were taken as captives in Babylon. Then came the persecution of the Greeks and later the Romans, which lasted for several centuries.

These persecutions have resulted in the burning and destruction of these testaments, the prevention from reading them and killing their rabbis and scholars.

Moreover, if the Bible is a divine revelation, how does it accept deletion, addition or review of its text from time to time?

Evidences for existence of distortions still exists in the texts of the current Old Testament:

“They should never again say, ‘This is the Lord’s revelation,’ because each person’s word becomes the revelation. They will twist the words of the living God, the Lord of Armies, our God.” [Jeremiah 23:36].

“How can you say that you are wise and that you have the Lord’s teachings? The scribes have used their pens to turn these teachings into lies.” [Jeremiah 8:8].

Are God’s prophets in the Old Testament infallible?

In the Old Testament, the prophets of God are accused of: worshiping idols, inflicting the brutal massacres to children and women, adultery, pandering, drinking alcohol, inciting theft, and conveying the religion of God by nudity and dancing

It is well known that whoever wants to distort any religion, they shall deliberately distort the infallibility and the image of its prophets. The more serious aspect is that this contradicts the infidelity of prophets, spreads immoral actions, corruption in the society, and promotes atheism ... or may encourage the society to search for the true religion ... and this is what has already happened in the western societies for hundreds of years.

- 23. Islam is the only religion all over the world where its followers worship their Creator as per His instructions and not as was written by some people in the so-called of Holy Books.**
- 24. Islam orders to be merciful to the weak and poor.**
- 25. Islam purifies the biography of Allah's prophets from any defects which non-Muslims accused them of.**
