



Where is Allah?

'Fi sama' (above the heavens), above His 'Arsh. He is Al-'Aalaa, the Most High, and nothing is higher than Him.





What is your Deen (religion)?

Islam is my Deen

Allah Says what means:

"Whoever desires a religion other than Islam it shall not be accepted from him and in the Hereafter he shall be among the losers because he will end up in the Fire made everlasting for him."

Azkar of day & night

Abu Hurairah (May Allah be pleased with him) reported:The Prophet (ﷺ) used to say in the morning:

اللهم بك أصبحنا، وبك أمسينا، وبك نحيا، وبك نموت، وإليك النشور

(O Allah! With Your Power we have come to the morning, with Your Power we come to the evening, with Your Power we live, and we die, and to You will we return)."







أَصْبَحْنا [أَمْسَينا] على فِطْـرَةِ الإِسْلامِ ، وَعَلَـى كَلِـمَةِالإِخْـلاص ، وَعلـى دينِ نَبِـيِّنا مُحَـمَّدٍ وَعَلـى مِلَّـةِ أبينـاإِبْـراهيـمَ حَنيـفاً مُسْلِـماً وَمـا كـانَ مِنَ المُشـركيـن

We have entered a new day upon the natural religion of Islam, the word of sincere devotion, the religion of our Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him), and the faith of our father Ibrahim. He was upright (in worshipping Allah), and a Muslim. He was not of those who worship others besides Allah.

When you say this in the evening, you should say: 'Amsaynaa 'alaa fitratil-'Islaam...: "We end this day..."

مِن شَرِّ ٱلْوَسُوَاسِ ٱلْخَنَّاسِ

from the evil of the lurking whisperer-

ٱلَّذِي يُوَسُوِسُ فِي صُدُورِ ٱلنَّاسِ

who whispers into the hearts of humankind—

مِنَ ٱلْجِنَّةِ وَٱلنَّاسِ

from among jinn and humankind."





Who is your Prophet?

Muḥammad ibn ʿAbd Allāh ibn ʿAbd al-Muṭṭalib ibn Hāshim



Why did Allah create us?

Allah created the creation to worship Him and not associate anything with Him.

Allah (the Exalted) said: "{And I did not create the jinn and mankind except to worship Me.}"
[51:56]





Allah's Messenger (may peace upon him) said:

Have taqwa (fear) of Allah wherever you may be, and follow up a bad deed with a good deed which will wipe it out, and behave well towards the people.

اتَّقِ اللَّهَّ حَيْثُمَا كُنْت، وَأَتْبِعْ السَّيِّئَةَ الْحَسَنَةَ تَمْحُهَا، وَخَالِقْ النَّاسَ بِخُلُقِ حَسَنِ







Azkar of day & night

Allah has promised that anyone who says this three times every morning or evening will be pleased on the Day of Resurrection.

رَضيتُ بِاللهِ رَبَّاً وَبِالإِسْلامِ ديـناً وَبِمُحَـمَّدٍ نَبِيّـاً

I am pleased with Allah as my Lord,
with Islam as my religion,
and with Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be
upon him) as my Prophet.
(Recite three times in Arabic.)









Azkar of day & night

Allah will write ten Hasanaat (rewards) for whoever recites this ten times in the morning, and forgive him ten misdeeds and give him the reward of freeing ten slaves and protect him from Satan. Whoever recites this ten times in the evening will get this same reward.

لا إِلهَ إِلاَّ اللَّهُ وحْـدَهُ لا شَـريكَ لهُ، لهُ المُـلْكُ ولهُ الحَمْـد،وهُوَ على كُلّ شَيءٍ قَدير

None has the right to be worshipped but Allah alone, Who has no partner.

His is the dominion and His is the praise and He is Able to do all things.

(Recite ten times in Arabic or one time to ward off laziness.)

and from the evil of the night when it grows dark,

what is al-Islam?

Al-Islam is that you worship Allah and do not associate anything with Him and you establish obligatory prayer and you pay the obligatory alms (Zakat) and you observe the fast of Ramadan.

what is Iman?

That you affirm your faith in Allah, His angels, His Books, His meeting, His Messengers and that you affirm your faith in the Resurrection hereafter.

what is al-Ihsan?

That you worship Allah as if you are seeing Him, and for if you fail to see Him





Abu Hurayra reported that the Prophet, may Allah bless him and grant him peace, said,

"Anyone who does not show mercy to our children nor acknowledge the right of our old people is not one of us."

لَيْسَ مِنَّا مَنْ لَمْ يَرْحَمْ صَغِيرَنَا، وَيُوَقِّرْ كَبيرَنَا.







Before performing wudu

بِسْمِ اللَّهِّ

In the Name of Allah

After performing wudu

أشهد أن لا إله إلا الله وحده لا شريك له، وأشهد أن محمدًا عبده ورسوله

I testify that there so no true god except Allah Alone, Who has no partners and that Muhammad ((ﷺ) is His slave and Messenger







After performing wudu

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "Whoever of you performs Wudu' carefully and then affirms: [I testify that there so no true god except Allah Alone, Who has no partners and that Muhammad ((ﷺ) is His slave and Messenger],' the eight gates of Jannah are opened for him. He may enter through whichever of these gates he desires (to enter)."

How to Perform Wudu

Prophet Muhammad PBUH was born in the year of the Elephant in the month of Rabi Al-Awwal.

What is the name of the nursing mother of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH)?


It is Halimah Al-Sa'diyah.

سُورَةُ الإِخْلَاصِ The Sincerity

قُلْ هُوَ ٱللَّهُ أَحَدٌ

Say, 'O Prophet,' "He is Allah—One 'and Indivisible'

ٱللَّهُ ٱلصَّمَدُ

Allah—the Sustainer 'needed by all'

He has never had offspring, nor was He born.

وَلَمۡ يَكُن لَّهُۥ كُفُوًا أَحَدُٰ

And there is none comparable to Him





What is the meaning of testifying there is no deity except Allah?

Believing that there is no one truly worthy of worship except Allah.

The proof is: "{Allah witnesses that there is no deity except Him ...}" [3:18]

What is the meaning of testifying that Muhammad is Allah's Messenger?

Believing that Muhammad (PBUH) is sent by Allah and must be believed, obeyed and followed. The proof is: "{And obey Allah and the Messenger that you may obtain mercy.}" [3:132]







The Prophet (ﷺ) said,

"He who believes in Allah and the Last Day, let him speak good or remain silent."

مَنْ كَانَ يُؤْمِنُ بِاللَّهِ وَالْيَوْمِ الآخِرِ فَلْيَقُلْ خَيْرًا أَوْ لِيَصْمُتْ







when getting into car / plane / bike & any transportation

سُبْحَانَ الَّذِي سَخَّرَ لَنَا هَٰذَا وَمَا كُنَّا لَهُ مُقْرِنِينَ

Far removed from imperfection is the One Who has made this subservient to us, for we have no power to subjugate it, and certainly to our Lord shall we return









When did the Prophet's mother pass away?

She passed away when he (PBUH) was six years old.

When did the Prophet's father pass away?

He passed away when Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) was in his mother's womb, so Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) was born as an orphan.

Who raised Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) after his mother's death?

He was raised in the house of his grandfather Abd Al-Muttalib until he died when the Prophet was 8 years old.

Then he moved to his uncle's house until he became a young man.

تَبَّتُ يَدَآ أَبِي لَهَبٍ وَتَبَّ

May the hands of Abu Lahab perish, and he 'himself' perish!

مَآ أَغْنَىٰ عَنْهُ مَالُهُۥ وَمَا كَسَبَ

Neither his wealth nor 'worldly' gains will benefit him.

سَيَصْلَىٰ نَارًا ذَاتَ لَهَب

He will burn in a flaming Fire,





سُورَةُ المَسَدِ The Palm Fiber

وَاْمُرَأَتُهُۥ حَمَّالَةَ ٱلْحَطَبِ

and 'so will' his wife, the carrier of 'thorny' kindling,

فِي جِيدِهَا حَبُلٌ مِّن مَّسَدُ

around her neck will be a rope of palm-fibre.





What is the greatest thing commanded by Allah?

Tawheed (Believing in Allah's Oneness): which means worshipping Allah alone, without any associate.

The Messenger (PBUH) said: "Allah has forbidden Hellfire for those who testify that there is no deity except Allah, seeking Allah's pleasure with that."







Abu Hurairah (May Allah be pleased with him)
reported:Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said,
"The believers who show the most perfect Faith are
those who have the best behaviour"

أكملُ المؤمنين إيمانًا أحسنُهم خُلقًا

Good Manners Way to Selection.







Upon hrearing the cocks crowing

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ مِـنْ فَضْـلِك

O Allah, I ask for Your favor

Abu Hurairah reported the Prophet (May peace be upon him) as saying: when you hear the cocks crowing, ask Allah for some of His grace, for they have seen as angel







What was the stature of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) among his people?

He was called the Truthful and Trustworthy, and he was the noblest in descent and the most perfect in appearance and manners among the people.

then glorify the praises of your Lord and seek His forgiveness, for certainly He is ever Accepting of Repentance.





What is the greatest thing forbidden by Allah?

The greatest thing that Allah forbade is Shirk (association), which means worshipping others alongside Allah (the Exalted).








Abu Hurairah (May Allah be pleased with him) reported:The Prophet (ﷺ) said,




Upon hearing a donkey braying


Muhammad

قُلُ يَٰٓأَيُّهَا ٱلۡكَٰفِرُونَ

Say, 'O Prophet,' "O you disbelievers!

لَّا أَعْبُدُ مَا تَعْبُدُونَ

I do not worship what you worship,

وَلَآ أَنتُمُ غُبِدُونَ مَاۤ أَعُبُدُ

nor do you worship what I worship.





سُورَةُ الكَافِرُونَ The Disbelievers

وَلَآ أَنَاْ عَابِدٌ مَّا عَبَدتُّمُ

I will never worship what you worship,

وَلَآ أَنتُمْ غَبِدُونَ مَاۤ أَعۡبُدُ

nor will you ever worship what I worship.

لَكُمْ دِينُكُمْ وَلِيَ دِينِ

You have your religion you thought up for yourselves, and I have my religion that Allah revealed to me.





Why can't see Allah in the worldly life?

Because our eyes cannot perceive Allah in the worldly life, as they are too weak to endure that. So, how can they see Allah, the Almighty, the Grand! However, the believers will see Allah (the Exalted) in Paradise, God willing.

"{Vision perceives Him not, but He perceives [all] vision; and He is the Subtle, the Aware.}" [6:103]





Abu Umamah (May Allah be pleased with him) reported: heard the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) saying, "Read the Qur'an, for it will come as an intercessor for its reciters on the Day of Resurrection."

اقْرَءُوا الْقُرْآنَ فَإِنَّهُ يَأْتِي يَوْمَ الْقِيَامَةِ شَفِيعًا لأَصْحَابِهِ







After Adhan (the call to prayer)

اللَّهُمَّ رَبَّ هَذِهِ الدَّعْوَةِ التَّامَّةِ وَالصَّلاةِ القَّائِمَةِ آتِ محَمَّداً الوَسيلةَ وَالْفَضيلَة وَابْعَثْه مَقَاماً مَحموداً الَّذي وَعَدْتَه [إِنَّكَ لا تُخْلِفُ الميعاد]

O Allah, Lord of this perfect call and established prayer. Grant Muhammad the intercession and favor, and raise him to the honored station You have promised him,

[verily You do not neglect promises].

So pray and sacrifice to your Lord 'alone'.

إِنَّ شَانِئَكَ هُوَ ٱلْأَبْتَرُ

Only the one who hates you is truly cut off 'from any goodness'.





Narrated Jabir (RA):The Prophet (ﷺ) said:

"Do not eat with the left hand, for the devil eats with the left hand."

لَا تَأْكُلُوا بِالشِّمَالِ ; فَإِنَّ اَلشَّيْطَانَ يَأْكُلُ بِالشِّمَالِ

Where did the Prophet (PBUH) live?

He (PBUH) lived in Mecca, the most sacred spot on earth.

Where did the Prophet (PBUH) migrate?

The Prophet (PBUH) migrated from Mecca to Madinah

When did the Prophet (PBUH) pass away?

He passed away on Monday in the month of Rabi' Al-Awwal in the 11th year after Hijrah (migration).
