

God is Love, Jesus Loves you, Christian and the Islamic Perspective

Allah Exalted He has ninety-nine beautiful divine names that also reflections of his essence, his eternal attributes, and attributes of his actions as well, one of these beautiful names is Allah's name Al-Wadūd (The Most Loving).

This divine beautiful name denotes the eternal qualities of Allah's essence, eternal attributes, and his eternal attributes of the action of Love.

Another two of those beautiful eternal names are The Most or Entirely Merciful in Arabic (Ar-Rahman) and The Bestower of Mercy in Arabic (Ar-Raheem).

Imam Ibnul Qayyim – may Allah have mercy upon him – states:

‘Ar-Rahman signifies Allah, the Glorified, attribute, while ‘Ar-Raheem’ signifies its relationship with the object of mercy. So, the prior is for a description and the latter is for an action.

The prior signifies that Mercy is His attribute, while the latter signifies that He is merciful towards His creation with His Mercy. To understand this, contemplate His saying:

And He is ever, to the believers, Merciful. Quran (33:43)

Indeed, He was Kind and Merciful to them. Quran (9:117)

‘Ar-Rahman’ followed by ‘with them/to them’ never comes in the Quran [1].

So, it becomes known that Ar-Rahman is: the One who is attributed with mercy, and Raheem is the One who applies mercy upon His creation.

Badā'i al-Fawid: 2/34

Imam Ibn ‘Uthaymeen – may Allah have mercy upon him – explains:

‘Ar-Rahman’ – He is attributed with vast mercy because this word form in the Arabic language signifies vastness and fullness.

‘Ar-Raheem’ – a noun that signifies the action [2]. When combined, ‘Ar-Rahman’ and ‘Ar-Raheem’ mean that Allah's mercy is vast and reaches the creation.

This is what some scholars alluded to by saying:

‘Ar-Rahman’ is a universal mercy [to all the creation] and ‘Ar-Raheem’ is a specific mercy for the believers.

Since Allah’s mercy upon disbelievers is specific to the life of this world only, it is as if there is really no mercy upon them, because in the afterlife, when they ask Allah to remove them from the Hellfire, and seek intercession with Allah through His Lordship, and confess against themselves saying:

“Our Lord! Take us out of it, if ever we return (to evil), then indeed we are oppressors” Quran (23:107)

They will not find mercy, rather they will find justice, Allah – the Mighty and Majestic – will say to them:

“Remain in it in humiliation! And speak not to Me!” Quran (23:108)

Not by love alone Humanity survives.

As utopian and romantic as it sounds, Christianity claims that it preaches “love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you” Matthews 5:44 and Christians claim to follow those teachings.

However, we have never heard that any army in the world has a lovers training center or they train their soldiers to throw their enemies with flowers and perfume bottles.

Both history and reality has proven time after time that almost every single in the world not only has armed forces and armed Police force but also, dedicate enormous budgets and huge resources to those forces.

Countries with Judeo-Christian heritage are no exception Countries with Judeo-Christian heritage are the world’s leading countries in having the biggest and most advanced armed forces and armed police forces, not just by relying on importing weapons but also, on being the major manufacturers and exporters of different types of weapons to the rest of the world.

History and reality prove that Countries with Judeo-Christian heritage have run multiple crusade campaigns against many Muslim countries over past centuries till today, former US president George Bush declared it loud and clear when intended to invade Iraq and Afghanistan.

All the above prove □ beyond reasonable doubt the impracticality, unrealistic and fantasy of “love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you” Matthews 5:44

Humanity can not survive with love alone; Justice is a critical requirement for the survival of humanity and that is what Islam teaches. Not by love alone Humanity survives.

**The reward of an evil deed is its equivalent (Justice requirement)
Allah, He states in the Glorious Quran:**

“The reward of an evil deed is its equivalent. But whoever pardons and seeks reconciliation, then their reward is with Allah. He certainly do □s not like the wrongdoers.” Quran (42:40)

Also, Allah in the Glorious Quran tells us the Prophet Noah mocked in return those who rejected the message of Allah and mocked him:

“So, he ‘Noah’ began to build the Ark, and whenever some of the chiefs of his people passed by, they mocked him. He said, “If you laugh at us, we will ‘soon’ laugh at you similarly. Quran (11:38)

Love without Justice is Injustice:

Christianity has some sloga □s that we usually hear its adherents repeatedly parroting, such as God is love and Jesus loves you. While they are constantly parroting those slogans and during the process of hammering non-Christians with those cliches. They tend to overlook the fact that love without Justice is an injustice.

An unconditional love regardless of the actions and behaviors of the person receiving love is a recipe for a disaster, it is l □ke a country claiming to be a pacifist without preparing for dire situations such as wars, civil unrest, or even natural disasters.

Disassociating between Love and justice in the Christian doctrine that carries with it firm and fair disciplinary punishments for those who violat □ the rules, has resulted in huge problems in countries with Judeo-Christian heritage.

Statistics do not lie, with a quick comparison between crime types and ratios in two countries such as the United States and for example the biggest Muslim country, which is Indonesia, you would □e able to easily understand the difference.

We are not claiming here that Indonesia is a perfect Muslim country, on the opposite we acknowledge that there are lots of violations of Islamic teachings.

Islam's God of love has long been obscured from the Western mind by Christian exertions of Jesus' God of love and Christians as a loving community.

Despite noticeable contextual and sociohistorical differences, Islam, however, may have a version of the loving God and a community of love that bears not only a striking parallel to Christian biblical teaching about love but also excels by highlighting justice as an integral component goes hand in hand with love and cannot be segregated.

This exploration seeks to unveil noteworthy some aspects of that parallel within the frameworks of each religion and highlight love and justice as a realistic approach to addressing the human nature.¹

Christianity tends to romanticize love, how God loves you

(Even if you were non-Christian which is incorrect- simply because if you die not Christian, you're not going to Christian heavens).

Unity in Plurality as Christian Expression of Love? Called POLYTHEISM

Christians tend to mix and mince the two natures of Prophet Jesus who is a one hundred percent human Prophet who was born from a miraculous virgin birth and between the nature of God as a unique, supreme, all-loving, and all-justice as per Islam.

Unity in plurality is in reality pure Paganism such a corrupt concept tends to mix and mince between the Unique nature of God and the human nature Of Prophet Jesus. In Islam no such unity in plurality, Islam stresses the Oneness nature of Allah Exalted He in everything.

God's Love goes hand in hand with His mercy and Justice in Islam

Islam's understanding of God as love derives from Allah's name as Al-Wadu'd (The Most Loving) ascribed in the Qur'an:

"So, seek your Lord's forgiveness and turn to Him in repentance. Surely my Lord is Most Merciful, All-Loving." Quran (11:90)

And Quran (85:14)

"And He is the All-Forgiving, All-Loving" Quran (85:14)

And from the attribution of this name which an intricate Islamic theology unfolds. Check Allah's beautiful names and attributes article at the end of the page.

Love without Justice and Mercy is a Flawed Christian concept:

The Christian tradition focuses on John's statement that "God is love" (1 John. 4:8), from which a trinitarian theology is constructed with love as a relational property—first among the three Persons in the godhead as per the Christian belief, and second as an extension from God through Jesus to humanity expressed in the command,

"Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another" (John. 13:34).

Principle of Peace in Action

Once again, we see the distorted Gospel maligning the Messenger of Allah, Jesus, the son of Mary, accusing him of wanting to set the world on fire and regretting that he didn't see it burn (Luke 12:49).

As is well-known, Christians continually proclaim day and night that the Jesus mentioned in the distorted Gospel is the Prince of Peace and without sin. We hope they would read their corrupted book.

Some meeting Points

Similarities with the Christian discourse on God as "being love" can be drawn from Islamic concepts that differentiate the Divine Names (Asma') and Attributes (Sifat) and distinguish the attributes of essence (al-dhahat) from those of action (af'al).

This distinction establishes the nature of Allah's name as "The Most Loving" and Allah's act of loving about the attributes of essence and action. In this sense, Islam's "The Most Loving" can mean "God is love" because the divine names and attributes are intimately connected in Islamic theology.²

If a divine name denotes a quality of Allah's essence—in this case, the most loving Al-Wadūd—then the name would relate the corresponding attribution to Allah as "being love," like the way Christianity interprets the idea that "God is love."

This is true because, while a name refers to Allah Exalted He, the corresponding eternal attribute is a quality by which Allah is identified. In other words, while the name designates Allah with the title, "The Most Loving," the attribute "loving" refers to the identity or ascription of Allah.

Islam expands its belief in tawhīd al-Asmā wa al-Siḳāt (the oneness of divine names and attributes) by describing the attributes associated with some names as “attributes of action” (ṣifat afʿal) and those associated with other names as “attributes of the essence” (ṣifat al-dhāt).³

The attribute wadūd (love) is one of Allah’s beautiful eternal names and is considered to be an eternal attribute of action as well.

In Arabic, “wud” means “love” as an expression of action or the act of loving. Theologically, if “loving” were an attribute of Allah’s essence, then it would precede divine action. Yet, loving is held to be antecedent, which implies that Allah “is” love by virtue of the divine name Al-Wadūd, inferring that the attribute applies both at the time of loving action and before it in the divine essence.

This seems reasonable when accounting for the idea of divine potency before divine act.

This theologizing may be what distinguished “the names of the names (asma al-asma), which are the names voiced in human language for us to understand, and the names in themselves which are realities in divinis.”⁴

Insofar as any distinction between essence and action is in the attributes and not in the names, then, Allah’s love, mercy and justice—given that Allah possessed the divine beautiful names from all eternity—is an attribute of essence.⁵

If “Allah does not desire any wrong for (Allah’s) servants”

“For Allah would never will to wrong His servants.” Quran (40:31)

Then wud (love) is an attribute of divine essence, in a sense requiring the conception of agency.⁶ Allah’s loving, therefore...

Note:

There are no blank cheques of Love for anyone in Islam even for a Muslim unless a person dies on Islam trying their best to fulfill the true and pure teachings of Islam, which would make them eligible for Allah’s mercy, and his mercy preceded his anger and wrath.

Allah Exalted he say in The Glorious Quran:

“But My mercy encompasses everything. I will ordain mercy for those [Muslims who die on Islam] who shun evil, pay alms-tax, and believe in Our revelations.” Quran (7:156)

Therefore those who reject Islam and, associate, and join partners with Allah Exalted He in worship, have earned his anger and wrath, Hence Allah's justice comes first and no mercy or love for anyone who heard about Islam and insisted on rejecting worshipping the only true God, Allah Exalted He.

There is no religion on Earth planet that grants equal love, a pleasant destination to anyone and everyone whether they follow or unfollow their teachings. Obviously, Christianity is no exception.

For this and other reasons Christianity and other religions are inviting others to join them. Even on a human level it would be very unfair to equate between good law-abiding citizens and criminals.

The Irrationality of the Christian concept of Love your enemy:

The only true religion of God is Islam, which includes not only the spiritual aspects of knowing about God, his oneness, beautiful eternal names, and eternal attributes, and how to worship him alone, but also Islam teaches us practical system that was sent to address real-life problems, human nature, and how to fix them accordingly.

The Unconditional Love for Non-Christians According to the Bible

Jesus loves you

If you believe that Jesus Christ is God, then you must believe that he inspired the Old Testament to humans, which includes Exodus 22:20, which commands that you kill anyone who worships other gods besides your God, Jesus Christ, whom you worship.

You have no right to argue that Exodus 22:20 has been superseded by the New Testament of the Bible.

Even if we assume that it has been superseded by the New Testament, Exodus is still evidence in the Old Testament that proves the bloodthirstiness, violence, and terrorism of the false God who commands killing and massacres against those who do not believe in him.

Islamic divine laws as a continuation of Prophet Moses's Laws and Approval Of Prophet Jesus:

Prophet Issa son of Maryam commonly known as Jesus son of Mary was quoted saying in Matthew 5:17:

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“Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.

Hence the Islamic divine laws revealed in the Glorious Quran by Allah Exalted He, are commonly known by Islamic Sharia laws.

Islamic Sharia has been unfairly tarnished by the anti-Islamic propaganda machine as portrayed as backward barbaric horrible unjust laws. While arrogantly and ignorantly promoting such lies and misconceptions about Islamic Sharia laws through depicting for instance an Afghan or Saudi policeman lashes a woman or anything that demonizes Islamic Sharia laws.

Presumption of God's love: Christian arrogance and Assurance of Heavens.

Allah Loves These 8 Specific Types of People as Mentioned in the Quran

When looking through the Quran, one will come across many instances whereby Allah explicitly mentions that He loves a certain type of person. These are 8 types of people Allah loves.

1. Those who do good

Allah says, “And spend in the way of Allah and do not throw (yourselves) with your (own) hands into destruction (by refraining). And do good; indeed, Allah loves the doers of good.” Quran (2:195).

2. Those who repent

He says, “... Allah loves those who are constantly repentant...” Quran (2:222).

3. People who purify themselves

Allah says, “And when they have purified themselves, then come to them from where Allah has ordained for you... (Allah) loves those who purify themselves.” Quran (2:222).

4. The Patient ones

“...And Allah loves the steadfast.” Quran (3:146).

5. God-conscious people

“But yes, whoever fulfills his commitment and fears Allah – then indeed, Allah loves those who fear him.” Quran (3:76).

6. Those that put their trust in Allah

“... And when you have decided, then rely upon Allah. Indeed, Allah loves those who rely (upon Him).” Quran (3:159).

7. The just ones

“(They are) avid listeners of falsehood, devourers of (what is) unlawful. So if they come to you, (O Muhammad), judge between them or turn away from

them. And if you turn away from them – never will they harm you at all. And if you judge between them with justice. Indeed, Allah loves those who act justly.” Quran (5:42).

8. One who when they fight (evil) in His way, they do so united

“Indeed, Allah loves those who fight in His cause in a row as though they are (single) structure joined firmly.” Quran (61:4).

Let us try and perfect these 8 characteristics in order to gain the pleasure of Allah

The Qualities that Allah Exalted He hates/dislike

Despite Allah’s universal mercy and care for all his creation through all the countless favours regardless of their religion, or even no religion. Allah will never forgive for anyone who die not Muslim after hearing about Islam.

Here are some of the Quranic verses about that:

“Certainly, Allah’s only Way is Islam” Quran (3:19)

“Surely those who receive our revelations with denial and arrogance, the gates of heaven will not be opened for them, nor will they enter Paradise until a camel passes through the eye of a needle. This is how We reward the wicked. Quran (7:40)

“Indeed, Allah does not forgive associating others with Him ‘in worship’,¹ but forgives anything else of whoever He wills. And whoever associates others with Allah has indeed committed a grave sin.” Quran (4:48)

Here are the qualities hated and disliked by Allah Exalted He, are hated even if a Muslim do them:

It does not mean a person is a Muslim that he/she has a green light to do whatever they want. On the contrary, a Muslim need to do his best to be a role model for everyone else.

1. Extravagance

“But waste not by excess: for Allah loveth not the wasters (Al-Musrifun (those who waste by extravagance)).” Quran (6:141)

Excessive spending and lavishness in everything are the core of evil and leads to greater evil. It makes one forget the hereafter and preparing for it. Such acts would be a cause of humiliation and disgrace on the Day of Judgment.

That is why Almighty Allah has prescribed zakah (obligatory alms) and sadaqah (voluntary charity) in order to bless the wealth and to curb extravagance in eating, drinking, clothing and in everything we do.

2. Pride

“Verily He loveth not the arrogant (proud).” Quran (16:23)

And the Prophet (Peace be upon him) says, “Pride is to completely disregard the truth and scorn (looking down upon) the people” [Muslim]

Sometimes a person might be deceived by his/ her knowledge, wealth and property, lineage and ancestry, or worship and be arrogant and boastful.

Al-Hasan Al-Basri (may Allah be pleased with him) advised that:

“Do not become proud merely because you worship often, for consider what happened to Iblis after he spent a great deal of time worshipping” (Gems and jewels – wise sayings, interesting events & moral lessons from the Islamic history, compiled by Abdul-Malik Mujahid (Darussalam))

Pride is among the greatest means of damage to a person’s wealth and circumstances. It distances one away from Allah’s love and “He who has in his heart the weight of a mustard seed of pride shall not enter paradise.” [Sahih Muslim, Book: 001, Hadith: 0166]

3. Arrogant Booster.

“For Allah loveth not any arrogant boaster.” Quran (31:18)

Being arrogant and boastful are a deadly combination – beauty, knowledge, wealth and noble lineage should be taken as gifts from Almighty Allah, and one should be humble and grateful for them rather than make them a means of pride and oppression.

Servants of Allah cannot be true to themselves as long as they are flattering themselves, walking in an arrogant manner and looking down on people who are inferior to them and not mix with them. The one who is arrogant in this world will be disgraced on the Day of Judgment.

Prophet Muhammad (Peace be upon him) says,

“The arrogant will be gathered on the Day of Judgment in the form of small ants. Humiliation will surround them from everywhere.”

[At-Tirmidhi]

4. Transgression.

“For Allah loveth not those given to excess (Transgression).” Quran (5:87)

Human characteristics have limitations, which if surpassed would be transgression and if one falls short of it, it would be a defect – for example, generosity has a limitation, when surpassed, it becomes extravagance, when courage is surpassed, it becomes rashness; when ibadah (worship) is surpassed, one falls into the risk of adopting bid’ah.

Narrated by Anas bin Malik (may Allah be pleased with him):

“A group of three men came to the houses of the wives of the Prophet (Peace be upon him) asking how the Prophet worshipped (Allah), and when they were informed about that, they considered their worship insufficient and said, “Where are we from the Prophet as his past and future sins have been forgiven.”

Then one of them said,

“I will offer the prayer throughout the night forever.”

The other said,

“I will fast throughout the year and will not break my fast.”

The third said,

“I will keep away from the women and will not marry forever.”

Allah’s Apostle came to them and said:

“Are you the same people who said so-and-so? By Allah, I am more submissive to Allah and more afraid of Him than you; yet I fast and break my fast, I do sleep, and I also marry women. So, he who does not follow my tradition in religion, is not from me (not one of my followers).” ‘

[Sahih Bukhari, Book: 62, Hadith: 1]

Therefore, moderation is the best way to deal with all matters – it is not to exaggerate and make it hard for ourselves by prohibiting the permissible things. And not to transgress the limits by excessively indulging in the permissible matters but rather we should only use what satisfies our need and not fall into extravagance.

5. Evil, Wrongdoing.

“But God loveth not those who do wrong (oppressors, polytheists and wrong doers).” Quran (3:57)

This is a reprehensible trait whose existence spoils the Iman and darkens the heart. The wrongdoers are those who have chosen the tempting

transient life instead of the hereafter. All acts of wrongdoing such as stealing, breach of trust, embezzlement, usurping the rights of others, and bribery, have serious consequences in the hereafter.

In a Hadith, Abu Dharr (may Allah be pleased with him) reported Allah's Messenger (Peace be upon him) as saying that Allah, the Exalted and Glorious, said:

“My servants, I have made oppression unlawful for Me and unlawful for you, so do not commit oppression against one another.” [Sahih Muslim, Book: 032, Hadith: 6246]

6. Deceitfulness.

“For Allah loveth not the treacherous.” Quran (8:58)

The treacherous one is two-faced and inconsistent in words and deeds. Acts of treachery lead to betrayal, disloyalty, perfidy, deception, and hypocrisy which in turn soil the Iman.

7. Mischief-Making.

“And Allah loveth not those who do mischief.” Quran (5:64)

This is a comprehensive term which includes great crimes, sins, oppression, carrying false tales, hypocrisy, tyranny, and all kinds of mischief. All these acts are despicable and stain the Iman.

Hasten today to adopt the qualities that Almighty Allah loves and don't rest until they become second nature to you; hasten today to abandon all the qualities Allah does not love and don't relent until you hate them with all your heart.

The Prophet (Peace be upon him) said:

“Faith wears out in the heart of any one of you just as clothes wear out, so ask Allah to renew the faith in your hearts.”

Reference: [Al-Haakim in Al-Mustadrak and Al-Haythami in Majma Az-Zawaa'id]

Therefore, the key is supplication, resorting to Allah and sincere desire to please Him followed by action, so we say, “O Allah make Iman beloved to us and beautify it in our hearts.”

8. Publicity of Evil.

“Allah does not like that evil should be uttered in public except by him who has been wronged. And Allah is Ever All-Hearer, All-Knower.” Quran (4:148)

This is very common in our Ummah=community now, people commit sins openly and also when they do certain sins people don't know about, they come and announce it with pride these people call upon Allah's wrath is a dangerous thing to do.

9. Obscene words and acts.

Ahmed narrated: Allah's Messenger (Peace be upon him) said:

"Allah hates obscene words and acts." Again, one of the most common disease our Ummah=Muslim community is suffering from. They use obscene language and think they are cool or just for fun.

10. Treachery.

"Verily, Allah likes not any treacherous ingrate to Allah [those who disobey Allah but obey Satan]." Quran (22:38)

11. Oppression.

"Verily, He likes not the Thalimun (oppressors, polytheists, and wrongdoers)." Quran (42:40).

12. Corruption.

"And Allah likes not mischief." Quran (2:205).

13. Betrayal.

"Verily, Allah does not like anyone who is a betrayer, a sinner." Quran (4:107).

14. Exultant for worldly Desires.

"Verily, Allah likes not those who exult (with riches, being ungrateful to Allah)." Quran (28:76)
